


**VISION**: A healthy environment for everyone in Maryland

- Geothermal Credits In the RPS (HB1007/SB810)
- PSC Climate And Labor Test (HB295/SB227)
- Coal Community Transition Act (HB66/SB148)



### Climate Solutions Now Act (as introduced)



#### **GOALS**

- 60% GHG reduction by 2030
- Net Zero emissions by 2045

**INCREASE** EMPOWER efficiency gains from 2% to 3%

#### **BUILDINGS**

- Reductions from retrofitted large buildings
- New state buildings need to be net neutral
  - Schools 1 per county would be net zero



### Climate Solutions Now Act (as introduced) - continued



**COMMISSION** on Env Justice and Sustainable Communities

• % of state climate change funds to impacted communities

#### TRANSPORTATION

MTA buses must be zero-emission after 2023

**WORK GROUP** on Just Transition

**SOLAR ROOFTOP** on LMI communities exempted from personal property tax

**METHANE MONITORING** at landfills

**PLANT 5 MILLION TREES** - 500,000 in urban environment




