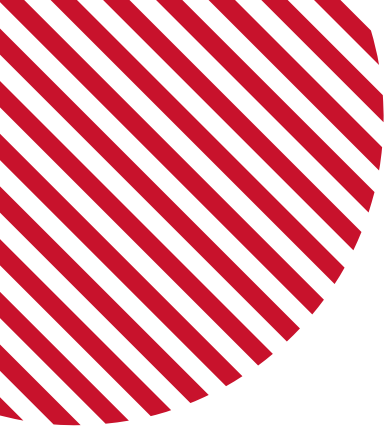

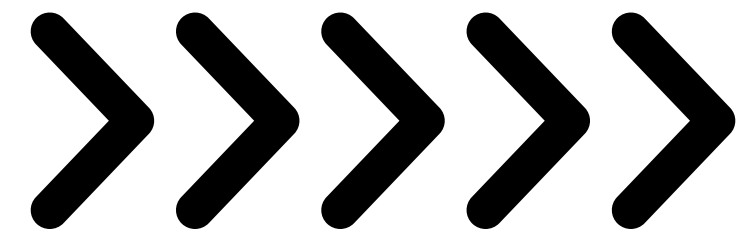

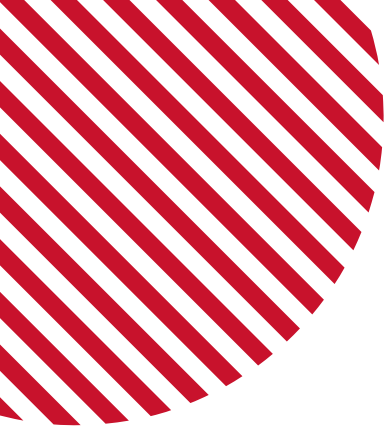




FIVE PILLARS FROM GOVERNOR MOORE

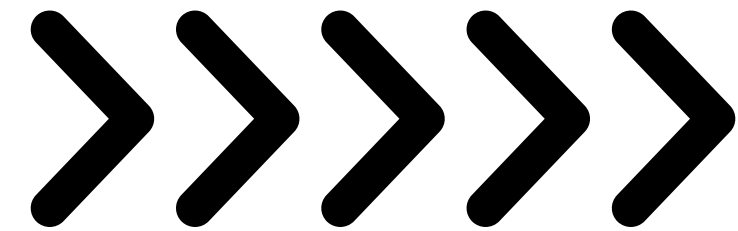
