### **TERMS & DEFINITIONS**

Primary & secondary bodily characteristics (chromosomes, hormones, etc.)

#### **Gender Identity**

Inner sense of being female or male (or some combination of the two)

#### **Sexual Orientation**

Attraction to members of one or more sexes

#### LGBTQ

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning/"queer"

#### **Gender Norms**

Socially-constructed ideals, scripts, expectations for "doing" Boy and Girl

### MASCULINITY EFFECTS

More risking-taking (sex, drugs) & violence

Drop out early / lower econ outcomes

Lower mental health outcomes/stress

Contact with police & JJ systems

Avoid trauma & health care

ED: Punished harshly for same infractions

JJ: Violated for subjective 'attitude' offenses

HLTH: Taken seriously, medicated sooner

HLTH: Undertreated for pain, cardiac symptoms




